I am in a higher risk category than the general population because I am a general contractor. Although my employer is not requiring me to get a CCW, because of what I do for a living, I am the target of attack and require a CCW. The threat to me are people who would attach to in order to take the valuable items I used for work. The kinds of items I use at work are my set of wrenches worth \$500, my air compressor worth \$1500, and the copper wire I have worth \$3,000.

My job takes me to all over San Diego County, including Santee, El Cajon, and Chula Vista. I am usually on the jobsite 6 days a week, as early as 7am, and as late as 8pm. My fear is that I will be attacked while working with the valuable material or followed and attacked when I am going about my normal daily activities.

I usually do home improvement projects for clients all over the county. I specialize in kitchens, bathrooms, and flooring. I typically meet with clients, give them a quote, and then do all the work myself or with a small crew of workers. I carry all my tools and supplies with me during and after work.

I have been a gun owner for 15 years and have been taught how to properly and safely use a firearm. Because my job as a contractor puts me in a higher risk category than the general public, I am requesting to be issued a California CCW.
